

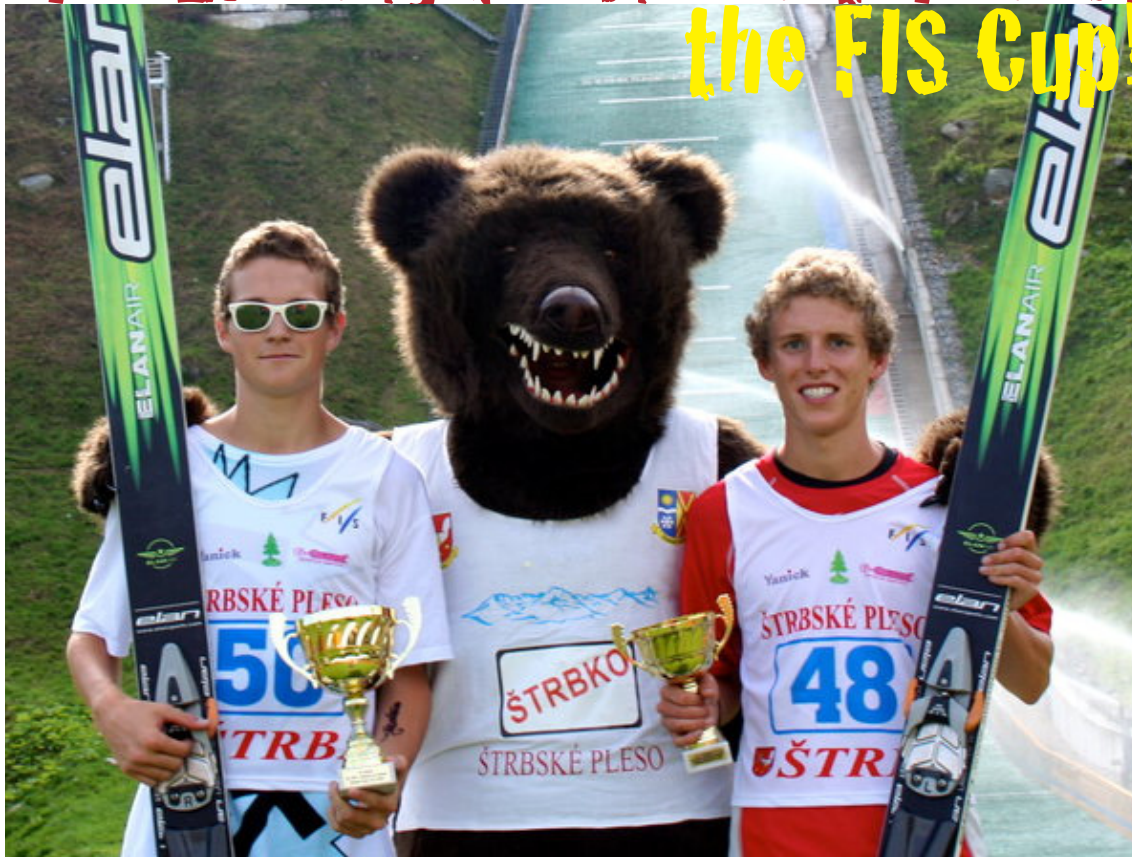

"Our goal as a team for this trip was to succeed at a FIS CUP level and build confidence before moving on to the Continental Cup" says Coach Gregor Linsig. "In Slovakia, Mac not only made it to the podium, but he won the FIS cup!"

Competing in Villach in the south of Austria on July 17 on HS100, Mackenzie Boyd-Clowes was ranked #4 and Yukon De Leeuw #28. On July 18 Mac ranked #18, Eric Mitchell #24 and Yukon DeLeeuw #45.

The big win was in Strbske Pleso, Slovakia, the highest settlement in the Tatra mountain range of Eastern Europe. On July 24, competing on the HS100, three Canadians were in the top 10! Mackenzie ranked #3 behind Slovakia and Russia, with Eric ranking #5 and Yukon #10. Mackenzie's big win was on July 25, when he ranked #1, Eric Mitchell #9 and Yukon DeLeeuw #34.
